

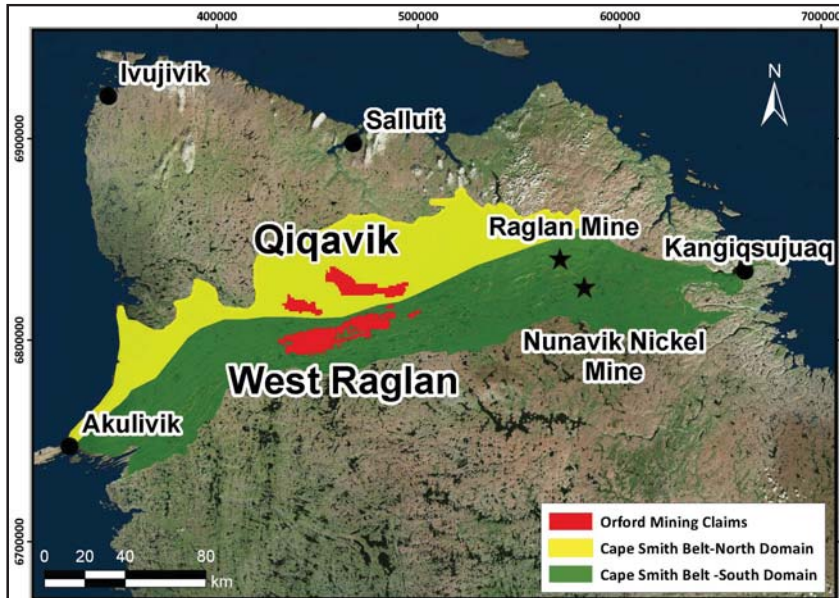

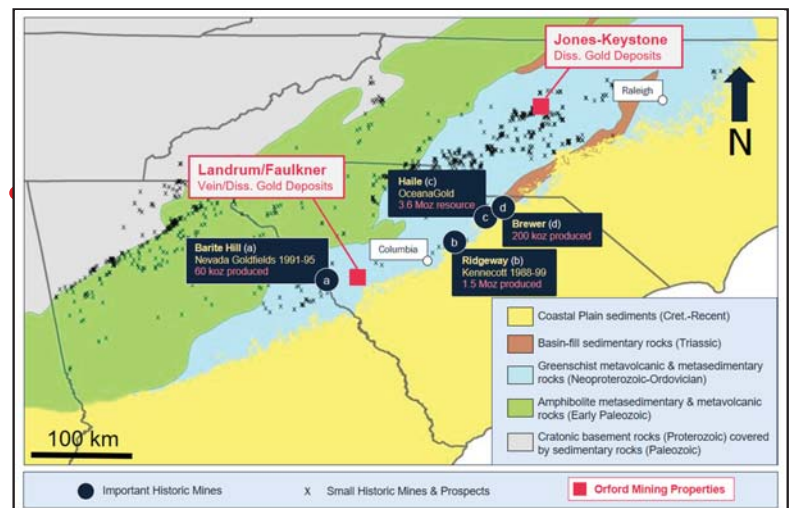


NORTHERN QUEBEC:

QIQAVIK 2017 EXPLORATION PROGRAM

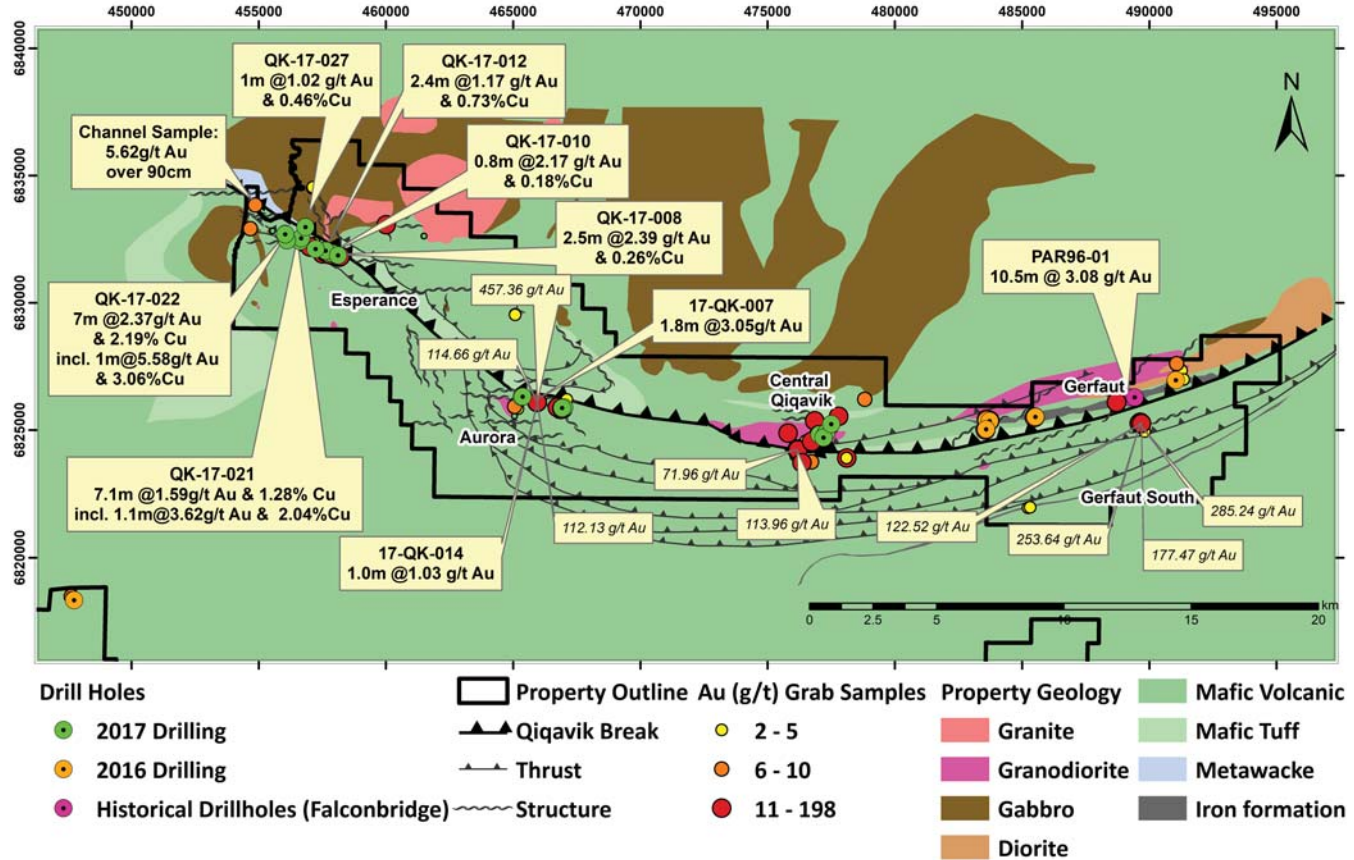
Program Summary

- Discoveries in a new gold belt in a previously unexplored region of Canada
- Orford has identified a significant structural break (the Qiqavik break) across the 40 km long Qiqavik property that holds huge potential for an economic gold discovery
- Confirmed 2016 surface discoveries at Aurora, Esperance and Esperance West: 14 of 19 drill holes intersected gold mineralization
- Five new surface discoveries: Aurora Central, Gerfaut South, Central Qiqavik, Horizon and Focused Intrusive
- A comprehensive multi-discipline program is being planned for the 2018 field season
